- The ACD has been placed on the LAT, first data with the full instrument tracker + calorimeter+ ACD) have been taken.
- The instrument will be shipped to NRL for environmental testing in mid February.
- Beam time has been granted at CERN for calibration tests, probably in Summer 2006.
- More accurate background model shows higher background fluxes. The latest "cuts" established to meet the requirements in terms of acceptance, residual background, downlink rate, hurt the acceptance for low-energy photons (E<100 MeV). This is still preliminary....</p>
